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HYPE Festival Performance Requirements

Dear Families,

After many hours of practice the Hype Performance is upon us. As you know our performances are on:

- Monday 5th August matinee and evening performance
- Wednesday 7th August evening performance only

Matinee performances: could all students please ensure they are at school no later than 9am..

Evening performances: students need to arrive at 6:00pm at Cambridge Park High School. Our holding rooms are located in the building directly across from the hall. A sign on and out table will be outside our holding rooms. We will have our school banner visible for families to know where to sign in and out. As the holding rooms are a high traffic area, only performers and supervising teachers are able to be in the holding rooms.

Please note there will be times when the rooms are unattended and we advise that all valuables including mobile phones are not brought in. Playing cards, books and activities are encouraged. The school excursion mobile number is 0467794177 should you need to contact us on the night.

In preparation for our performances there are a few requirements which we would like to request.

Matinee Performance: Could all students please come to school on Monday morning prepared to perform as follows:

Stage 1:

Girls: 2 high pigtails, neat and tidy

Mascara optional Foundation Pink lipstick Boys: Messy party hair

Foundation and mascara optional

Stage 2:

Girls: Foundation or tinted moisturiser on their face as close to natural skin colour as possible

Mascara to be already on eyelashes

Clear lip gloss in their bag, to be applied just before performances.

Sleek high ponytail Boys: Black shorts

Foundation and mascara optional

Stage 3:

Red and white group: Hair parted in 2 sections one side with a sleek ponytail or bun the other side with a loose ponytail that can be taken out and teased just before the performance

White group: long hair -hair tied back in sleek ponytail or bun at the back of the head

short hair – hair slicked back neat and tidy

Red group: Hair left out ready to be teased before performance

All students: Foundation Mascara

Choir: Hair tied or brushed back neat and tidy
