Taronga Zoo Overnight Excursion

Dear parent or caregiver,

Stage 2 will be going on an overnight excursion on Wednesday 24th July, 2019 to Thursday 25th July, 2019 and Thursday 25th of July 2019 to Friday 26th July 2019.

Accommodation will be at Taronga Zoo.

This excursion has been planned to supplement the following work being done in the classroom: 'Life Cycles' and 'What Changes Every Day?' being explored in Term 2.

The cost of the excursion is \$135.00 per student which includes \$16.00 for food.

The first group will depart at 4pm on Wednesday 24th July, 2019 and return at 3pm on Thursday 25th July, 2019. The second group will depart school at 4pm on Thursday 25th of July, 2019 and return on Friday 26th July, 2019 by 3pm.

Due to the large number of students we are taking two groups of a maximum amount of 60 in each group. We are limited to 120 students over the two nights (60 each night). Spaces will be given to the first 120 students who return their note and deposit.

Travel will be by bus.

The staff members with emergency care, anaphylaxis and CPR training are Mrs VanCuylenberg, Mrs Crocker, Miss Pellizon and Mr Fodor on night 1 and Ms Poole, Mrs Lodge, Miss O'Sullivan and Mr Bourke on night 2

Please note: students who have dropped to level 2 or lower between now and the end of the term may not be permitted to attend the excursion as stated in our Level System policy. The group will be supervised by Mrs VanCuylenberg and Mr Bourke.

Refunds for this excursion will only be given in line with the school's refund policy.

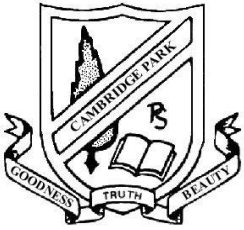
It will be used by the NSW Department of Education to assist planning, to support students, and to minimise risks when conducting school excursions, sporting or other school activities.

The cost of the excursion is **\$135**. Please fill out the permission note below and return to the school office with a deposit by **Friday 7th June 2019**.

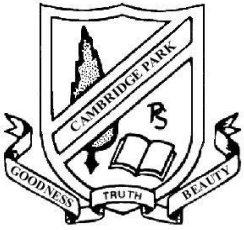

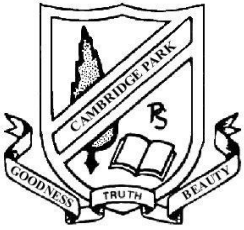
Sample Itinerary

- Supplying the medication and any 'consumables' necessary for its administration in a timely way.
- Collaborating with the school in working out arrangements for the supply and administration of the prescribed medication for the duration of the excursion.
- For some excursions the school will ask you to supply the medication in a different way to what has been already been agreed to by school. You may be asked to supply an additional adrenaline auto injector (i.e. EpiPen®) for example.
- The medication should be well within its expiry date.

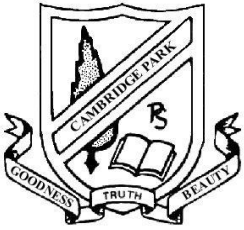
