What's happening?

Virtual Open Day

Wheel-a-thon Fundraiser

During Education Week students will also have the opportunity to participate in our annual fundraising event "Wheel-a-thon". Students are invited to bring their bike or scooters and helmets and ride the track on their allocated day.

The cost to participate is \$10.00 per child or \$25.00 for a family of 3 or more. The cost includes participation in the wheel-a-thon, sausage sandwich and drink, Zooper Dooper iceblock and disco at the end of the day. Please complete the permission note and return to the office with payment. Please note online payments are accepted however a signed permission note is still required.

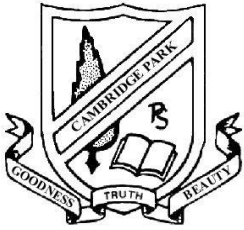
Wheel-a-thon allocated days

Students in these groups bring their bikes or scooters and helmet only on these days

Monday 3 August 2020:	Preschool and Kindergarten
Tuesday 4 August 2020:	Stage 3 – Years 5 and 6
Wednesday 5 August 2020:	Stage 1 – Years 1 and 2
Thursday 6 August 2020:	Support Unit and Preschool
Friday 7 August 2020:	Stage 2 – Years 3 and 4

In the event of rain on your child's allocated day the wheel-a-thon will be held on the same day in the following week. A message will be posted to Dojo in the morning if there are any changes due to the weather.

All proceeds raised from the wheel-a-thon will go towards building our bike, walking and fitness track.

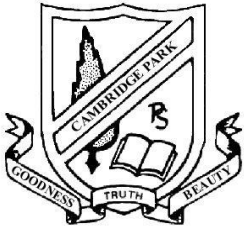
A failure to provide the information may mean that your child can not participate in a particular excursion or school activity. In such circumstances the school will make available a sound alternative educational experience.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

When a medical practitioner has prescribed medication (including emergency medication) that will need to be administered during the excursion, parents are responsible for:

- Bringing this need to the attention of the school.
- Ensuring that the information is updated if it changes
- Supplying the medication and any 'consumables' necessary for its administration in a timely way.
- Collaborating with the school in working out arrangements for the supply and administration of the prescribed medication for the duration of the excursion.
- For some excursions the school will ask you to supply the medication in a different way to what has been already been agreed to by school. You may be asked to supply an additional adrenaline auto injector (i.e. EpiPen®) for example.
- The medication should be well within its expiry date.
